WGSS 4999, Directed Readings, gives students an opportunity to do in-depth work on a chosen topic. The student must obtain permission of the instructor with whom the student will work as well as the permission of the Director of Undergraduate Studies in the Institute for Women's, Gender, and Sexuality Studies. Both student and instructor will decide upon a project that the student will complete during the semester. The instructor is responsible for meeting with the student at agreed-upon times during the semester, for guiding and evaluating the student's work, and for assigning a grade. The student is responsible for completing the requirements agreed upon with the instructor. WGSS is responsible for keeping accurate records of the project.
